5. The Master, etc, etc,

The above mentioned Toasts are as they should be printed on the Toast Lists for all Lodge Installations and other Masonic Dinners. They are correctly described and are placed in the order in which they should be proposed.

Toast 1 and 2 should be introduced with the word “Brethren”, and may be made whilst waiters/waitresses are still in the room

At Toast 3 it is recommended that the full address to those present is made by the proposer of the Toast, i.e., “Very Worshipful Deputy Provincial Grand Master in Charge/Assistant Provincial Grand Master(s), Grand Officers, Provincial Grand Officers, Worshipful Brethren and Brethren”. Following which other Toasts can then be introduced with minimal preamble such as “Worshipful Master and Brethren” or “Worshipful Brethren and Brethren”.

If the National Anthem is sung or played in the Lodge it should not be repeated at the Festive Board

The Honorifics (printed in italics) should be printed on the Toast List but omitted when verbally proposing the Toast
